From the time of diagnosis, through the course of treatment, and even after treatment is completed, individuals diagnosed with cancer and their caregivers have a wide range of needs. The American Cancer Society understands those needs and can offer information, day-to-day help, and emotional support to help you through every step of the cancer experience.

Transportation assistance

Our Road To Recovery[®] volunteers provide transportation to and from treatment for people with cancer who are too ill to drive or whose family members, friends, and neighbors are unable to provide transportation.

Lodging During Treatment

Facing cancer is hard. Having to travel away from home for treatment can make it even harder. At the 31 American Cancer Society Hope Lodge[®] facilities across the country, cancer patients and their families can find help and hope. The Society also offers discounted and - sometimes free - lodging through partnerships with hotels.

Finding Hope and Inspiration

The Cancer Survivors NetworkSM, a global online community, transcends geographic boundaries and builds bonds among cancer survivors and caregivers through shared experiences and feelings.

Help with Appearance-related Side Effects

Look Good Feel Better[®] individual and group sessions teach cancer patients techniques to help restore their appearance, improve their self-esteem, and help them approach their disease and treatment with greater confidence.
