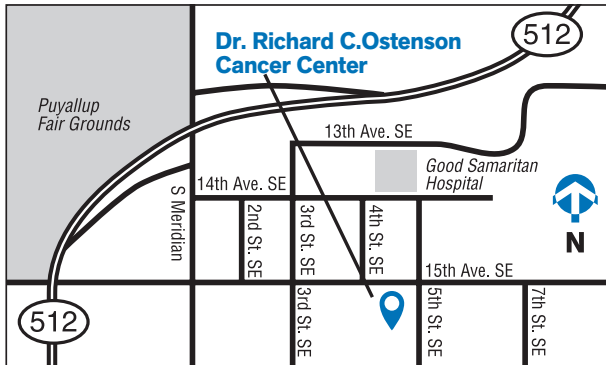


GETTING THERE:
